- **These** are for **many things** (plural): These are my books.

We use **That** and **Those** for things **far** from us.

- **That** is for **one thing** (singular): That is her car.
- **Those** are for **many things** (plural): Those are their bags.

We use **Possessive Adjectives** to show who owns something: my, your, his, her, its, our, their.

- This is **my** money. That is **his** wallet. These are **their** ideas.

We can also show possession with **'s**: Ricky 's, Mom 's, Dad 's.

- This is **Ricky's** phone. That is **Mom's** credit card.
