We use **This** and **These** for things **near** us.

- **This** is for **one thing** (singular): This is my phone.
- **These** are for **many things** (plural): These are my books.

We use That and Those for things far from us.

- That is for one thing (singular): That is her car.
- Those are for many things (plural): Those are their bags.

We use Possessive Adjectives to show who owns something: my, your, his, her, its, our, their.

• This is **my** money. That is **his** wallet. These are **their** ideas.

We can also show possession with 's: Ricky's, Mom's, Dad's.

• This is **Ricky's** phone. That is **Mom's** credit card.
