A Day at the Farm

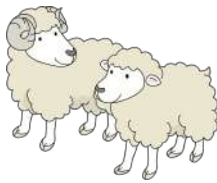
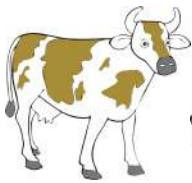
