#### Fun Pair Practice:

Ask partner: "What do you eat for dinner?"

Partner answers, then mimes eating dramatically  
(big "mmm!" or "yuck!" face).

Swap.

#### Examples

- Soup is hot and tasty.
- Salad is healthy and fresh.
- Pasta is yummy and cheesy.
- Chicken is delicious and juicy.

## Part 4: Present Simple Fun – My Day

Circle the correct answer:

- I \_\_\_\_\_ (eat / eats) rice for lunch.
- Dinner \_\_\_\_\_ (is / are) at 7 pm.
- We \_\_\_\_\_ (like / likes) pasta.

**Chain game:** Student 1: "I eat soup for dinner."

Student 2: "I eat fish..." (go around class – silly answers OK for laughs).

**Healthy vs Fun:** "I eat vegetables – healthy! But sometimes junk food – yummy!"

**Quick Review Game: "What's Missing?"** (5–10 min pair activity)

- Look at your menu (or flashcards).
- Your partner closes their eyes.
- You point to 5 items on the menu.
- Partner opens eyes and says: "You have soup, chicken, rice..."
- Then swap!

Who remembers more?

**My Lunch/Dinner Picture** (drawing & speaking – creative fun)

Draw your favourite lunch or dinner plate (use simple lines – no need to be an artist!).

Include 3–5 items from the menu (e.g., pasta + salad + juice).

Show your partner and say:

- "This is my lunch/dinner."
- "I like pasta – it's yummy."
- "I have salad – it's healthy."
- "I drink juice."

Partner asks: "Do you like spicy food?" or "Is it hot?"

**Bonus: Quick Yes/No Circle Game** (whole class – energizer)

Stand in a circle (or stay seated). Teacher starts with a ball or points.

Throw/say to next person: "Do you eat fish for dinner?"

They answer "Yes, I do" or "No, I don't" and throw to next: "Do you like dessert?"

Keep going fast – wrong answer = fun silly face or thumbs down!

(Laughs guaranteed – builds yes/no + short sentences.)
