### Activity A – What Is a Preposition?

A preposition shows where, when, or how something happens. It often comes before a noun.

Preposition	Use	Example
in	place/time	in the morning / in the box
on	place/time	on Monday / on the table
at	place/time	at school / at 5 o'clock
under	place	under the chair
before	time	before lunch
after	time	after dinner
with	manner/person	with my friend / with care
to	direction	to the park
by	method/person	by car / by my brother
