Warm-up Speaking

Talk with a partner:

- “What is something you are nervous about this week or next week?”

Role-Play Situations (Choose 2–3)

Situation 1: Before a Big Exam

A: I'm really nervous about tomorrow's exam.

B: You studied hard! **Break a leg!** You will do well.

Situation 2: Before a Job Interview

A: I have an important job interview in one hour.

B: Relax and be yourself. **Break a leg!** Show them how good you are.

Situation 3: Before a School Presentation or Performance

A: I'm so scared to speak in front of the class.

B: Take a deep breath. **Break a leg!** You've practiced a lot. You can do it!

Situation 4: Before a Sports Game or Competition

A: I feel so much pressure before the match.

B: You trained hard for this. **Break a leg!** out there! Go and enjoy it!

Fun Activity: Break a Leg! Chain Game

Stand in a circle. One student says something they feel nervous about. The next student encourages them by saying “Break a leg!” + one positive sentence, then shares their own worry. Continue around the circle.

Pronunciation Practice

Practice saying “Break a leg!” with energy and a big smile. It should sound positive and encouraging.

Extra Fun Task

Create one new situation where you can use “Break a leg!” and share it with the class.
