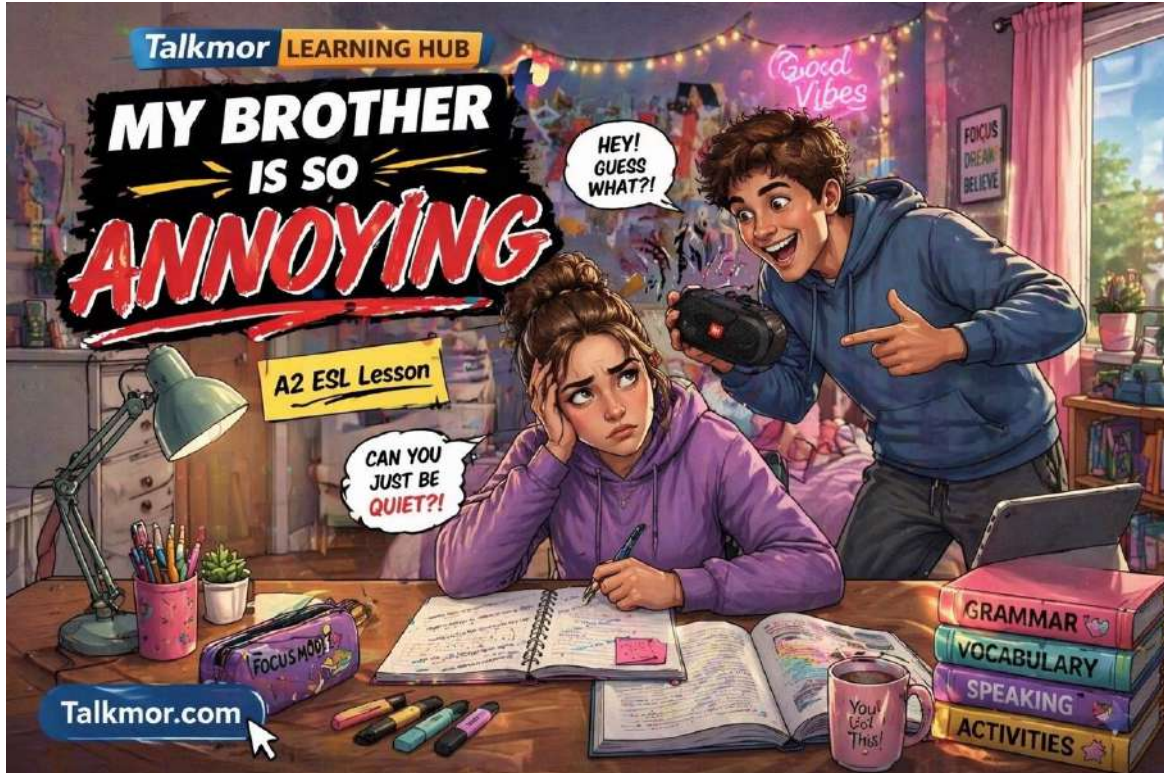

Grammar – Adverbs of Frequency + Present Simple

Rule: always → usually → often → sometimes → rarely → never

Position: Subject + adverb + verb

Example: Jake **always** disturbs Emma.
