SELF-CHECK KEY

1. Colors – Name 3 things that are ...

- red → tomatoes, apples, woman's red shirt, red roof/awning, red umbrella (far back)
- green → lettuce, leeks/spring onions, some stall roofs, tree leaves, some shirts
- orange → oranges, carrots, pumpkins
- yellow → man's shirt, some lemons, yellow roof (far back)
- brown → baskets, wheelbarrow, stall wood, tree trunks, some boxes

2. Fruits & Vegetables

- 4 fruits → apples, oranges, tomatoes, lemons
- 4 vegetables → carrots, lettuce, leeks/spring onions, cabbage, broccoli, cucumbers

3. Countable & Uncountable

1. tomato – C (we say "three tomatoes")
2. water – U (no water in picture → "There is no water.")
3. carrot – C
4. lettuce – U (we say "some lettuce" or "a head of lettuce")
5. apple – C
6. bread – U (no bread in picture → "There is no bread.")

4. Easy – Name 2 things that ...

- give shadow → trees, stall roofs/awnings, people, wheelbarrow
- hang → hanging tomato baskets, hanging herbs, hanging onions/garlic, lanterns
- you can carry → basket, shopping bag, box/crate, wheelbarrow
- are round → apples, oranges, tomatoes, lemons, wheel on wheelbarrow
- are on the table → carrots, lettuce, apples, oranges, tomatoes, leeks
