

## Play Like This

- green → plant in pot, boy's shirt (right), green circle on blackboard ...
- red → girl's hair (left), boy's shirt (middle), pink house roof ...
- yellow → sun drawing, boy's shirt (back), yellow circle on blackboard ...
- black → blackboard, dog's drawing, scribbles ...

#### 2. Easy – Name 2 things that ...

- you write with → pen, pencil (girl in back uses one)
- you sit on → chair, desk
- are on the blackboard → sun, house, cat, dog, bird, triangle ...
- you can draw → house, cat, dog, sun, circle, bird
- a teacher uses → chalk/pointer (in hand), blackboard
