



## GIVING & ASKING FOR DIRECTIONS

**Level:** True beginners (pre-A1/A1)

**Time:** 30-45 minutes

**Aim:** Students learn to ask for and give simple directions using basic phrases and prepositions.

**Materials needed:** Printed flash cards (PDF 2) and page 2 of PDF 3.

### 1. Key Vocabulary & Phrases (Teach first with pictures/gestures)

#### Asking for directions:

- Excuse me...
- Where is the [place]?
- How do I get to the [place]?
- Is the [place] near here?

#### Giving directions:

- Go straight (on).
- Turn left. / Turn right.
- It's next to the...
- It's opposite the...
- It's between the... and the...
- Go past the...
- Cross the road.

**Prepositions:** opposite, near, next to, across from, on the corner of, between, behind, in front of

#### Warm-Up Questions (Teacher → Student)

1. Is there a shop next to your house?
2. Is there a school near your home?
3. Where is the nearest supermarket?
4. Is there a park in your neighborhood?
5. Is there a hospital close to your street?
6. What is across from your house?
7. Is there a cinema in your town?
8. Where is the nearest police station?
9. Is there a coffee shop near your school/work?
10. What is next to your favorite shop?
