Activity 4: Memory Game

Cut out the cards (PDF 2 - Flashcards).

Play in pairs: match verb + picture or verb + sentence.

Activity 5: Word Bingo

Give students a 3x3 grid with 9 of the verbs.

Teacher calls out sentences → students mark the verb.



Activity 5: Standard Bingo

Give each student this 3x3 grid.

Call out the full sentences one by one (in any order).

Students listen and mark the correct verb with a cross (X) or circle.

First student to mark 3 verbs in a row (across, down, or diagonal) shouts “Bingo!”

Bingo Version 2: Different Grid Layout (for variety)

Give each student this bingo card.

Read the sentences slowly. Students mark the verb they hear.

The first student with a full row, column, or diagonal says “Bingo!”

- Every day I study English.
- Every day I play football.
- Every day I eat breakfast.
- Every day I watch TV.
- Every day my dad works in an office.

- Every day I live in a house.

Word Bingo Version 3: With One Free Space (easier & fun for beginners)

Instructions for the teacher:

Give each student this bingo card. The middle square is **FREE**.

Call out the sentences. Students mark the verbs they hear.

First student to get 3 in a row (including the free space) shouts “Bingo!”

Teacher calls out these sentences (mix the order – 8 sentences + free space):

- Every day I wake up early.
- Every day I go to school.
- Every day I watch TV.
- Every day I eat breakfast.
- Every day I play football.
- Every day I study English.
- Every day I like my English class.
- Every day my dad works in an office.
- (The last verb “live” can be added as a bonus or replaced if needed)

Teacher Tip:

You can print multiple copies with different grid arrangements so students don’t all have the same card. This keeps the game fair and exciting.
