Put Students First

Make Every Minute Count

Prioritize speaking practice in every lesson.

Use **real-world activities:** Order from menus, role-plays, timed challenges, pair work.

Keep it fun, simple, and engaging – no long explanations!
Infuse humor, creativity, and movement to keep energy high.
