Title: A1 Colours – Full Version

Teacher's Overview

Level: A1 (Beginner)

Duration: 40–55 minutes

This is a complete and practical lesson on colours for A1 students. Students learn colour words and practise using them with common everyday objects. The lesson goes beyond the basic kids version – it includes real-life objects, descriptions, and speaking activities.

Warm-up Activity (5–7 minutes)

Point to things in the classroom and ask:

- What colour is this pen?
- What colour is my shirt?
- What colour is the board?

Ask students about their favourite colour too.

Target Language:

- Basic colours: red, blue, green, yellow, black, white, pink, orange, purple, brown, grey
- It's **red**. / The bag is **blue**.
- My favourite colour is...
- Colours + common objects (bag, car, shirt, house, etc.)

Teaching Tips:

- Teach colours in groups of 6–8 first, then add more.
- Always combine colours with nouns (e.g. “a red apple”, “a blue car”) – this is more useful than colours alone.
- Use real classroom objects and students' clothes as much as possible.
- Encourage students to describe things they own or see every day.
