#### Title: A1 My Family – Extended

#### Teacher’s Overview


**Level: A1 (Beginner)**

**Duration:** 30–45 minutes

This is a very popular and useful topic. Students learn to talk about their family members in a simple, natural way. They will practise names, ages, family relationships, and basic descriptions.

#### Warm-up Activity (Fun & Easy – 5 to 7 minutes)

Start the lesson in a relaxed and friendly way:

1. Show a picture of a happy family (next page .
2. Ask the class:
  - “Is this a big family or a small family?”
  - “How many people are in this family?”
  - “Do you have a big family or a small family?”
3. Ask individual students:
  - “How many brothers do you have?”
  - “How many sisters do you have?”
  - “What is your father’s / mother’s name?”

#### Target Language:

- This is my mother / father / brother / sister / grandmother / grandfather...
- His / Her name is ...
- He / She is ... years old.
- I have ... brothers / sisters.
- I don’t have any brothers / sisters.
