#### Title: A1 Prepositions of Place

Level: A1 (Beginner)

Duration: 40–55 minutes

This is a very practical and essential lesson. Students learn common prepositions of place (in, on, under, next to, behind, in front of, between...) to describe where things and people are located. The lesson is clear, highly visual, and helps students build confidence when describing rooms, classrooms, pictures, and everyday situations.

#### Warm-up Activity (5–7 minutes)

Use real classroom objects or point around the room and ask:

- Where is the book? (It's **on** the table.)
- Where is the bag? (It's **under** the chair.)
- Where is Maria? (She's **next to** Ahmed.)

Encourage short answers and repeat the prepositions clearly.

#### Target Language:

- in, on, under, next to, behind, in front of, between
- The book is **on** the table. / The cat is **under** the chair.
- Is the pen **in** your bag?
- Where is ... ? / It's ...

#### Teaching Tips:

- Use lots of real objects and classroom items during the warm-up — students remember better when it's physical and visual.
- Model pronunciation of each preposition clearly and have students repeat.
- Focus on the difference between “in” (inside), “on” (surface), and “under” (below).
- Encourage students to describe real places (their bedroom, the classroom, a picture) to make the language useful immediately.
