A1 After School

1. Warm-up (5 minutes)

Teacher asks students the questions below.

Students answer using full sentences.

- What time does school finish?
- What do you do after school?
- Do you do homework?
- Do you play sports or games?
- What do you do in the evening?



2. Model Dialogue

Listen and repeat with your teacher.

Model Dialogue

- A: What time does school finish?
B: School finishes at three o'clock.
A: What do you do after school?
B: First, I go home and eat a snack.
A: Do you do homework?
B: Yes, I do homework in the afternoon.
A: What do you do in the evening?
B: I watch TV or play with my friends.
