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### PDF 4 – Fun Activities

#### Activity 1 – Borrowing Bingo (10–12 minutes)

Easy mingling activity. Walk around and ask: “What is something you borrow from your brother/sister?” The “Bingo” makes it competitive and fun.

#### Instructions:

1. Use the Blank Bingo Cards on page 3 **OR** draw a 3x3 grid on your paper.
2. Walk around the classroom and talk to **different classmates**.
3. Ask: “What is something you borrow from your brother/sister?”
4. Listen to their answers and write it in **one** of the boxes.
5. When you have **any 3 answers in a row** (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal), shout “**BINGO!**” and you win!
6. You don’t need the full grid filled. Just three in a line is enough to win.

#### Activity 2 – “Borrowing Story” Chain (10 minutes)

Groups of 4. Start with: “Yesterday my sister used my things because...”
