



SPEAKING - MY FAMILY

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Level: A1 (Beginner)

Time: 25–40 minutes

Learning Goal

I can talk about my family members.

1. Warm-up (5 minutes)

Teacher asks:

- How many people are in your family?
- Do you have brothers or sisters?
- Who is the youngest in your family?

2. Model Dialogue

A: How many people are in your family?

B: There are five people in my family.

A: Do you have brothers or sisters?

B: I have one brother and one sister.

A: What does your father do?

B: My father works in an office.



3. Pair Work

Ask your partner:

1. How many people are in your family?
2. Do you have brothers or sisters?
3. How old are they?
4. What does your mother/father do?
5. Who is your favorite family member?

- I have ... (one brother / two sisters)
- My father / mother / brother / sister ...
- He / She is ... years old.
- He / She works as a ...

- Who cooks in your family?
- Do you have grandparents?

2. Family Tree Speaking

Draw a quick family tree (4–5 members).

Describe it to your partner:
