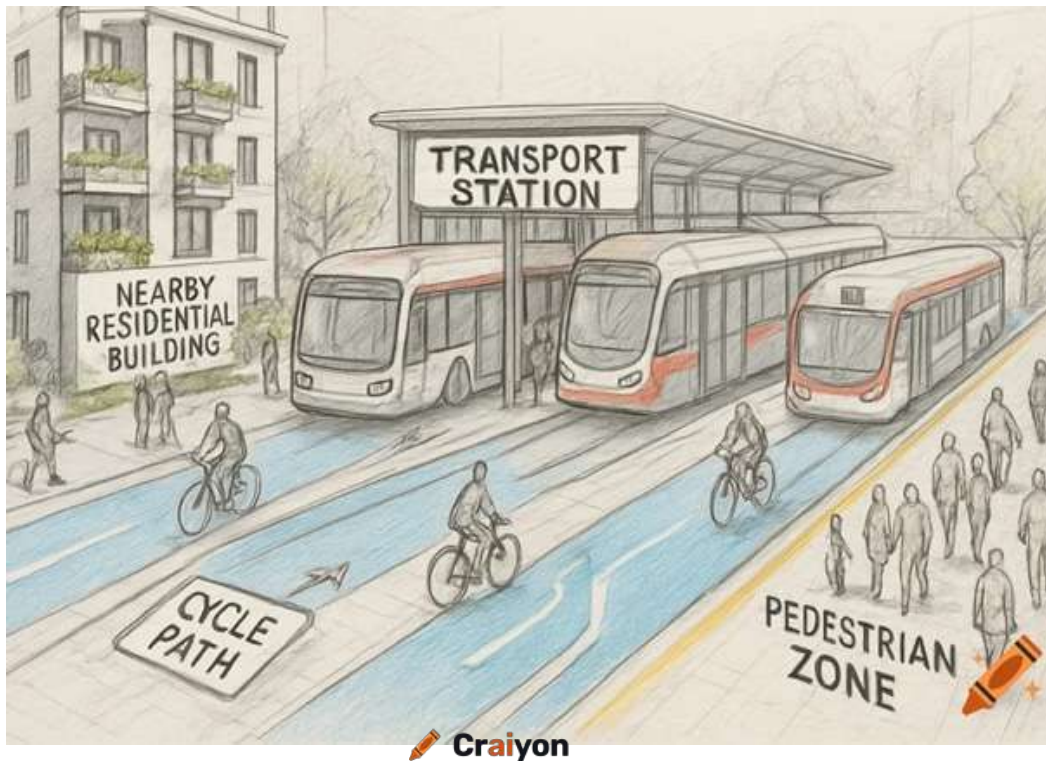
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Level: A1 (Beginner)

1. Warm-up (5 minutes)

Teacher asks:

- How do you go to school?
- Do you walk or take the bus?
- How long does it take?

Useful Phrases

- I go by bus / tram / bike / car
- I walk to ...
- It takes ... minutes
- How do you go to ...?

2. Model Dialogue

A: How do you go to school?

B: I go by bus.

A: How long does it take?

B: It takes twenty minutes.

A: Do you sometimes ride a bike?

B: Yes, I ride my bike when the weather is good.

4. Do you have a bike?
5. What is your favorite way to travel?
