### Learning Goal

I can talk about shopping for clothes.

### 1. Warm-up (5 minutes)

Teacher asks:

- Do you like shopping for clothes?
- What clothes do you like wearing?
- What did you buy last time?

### 2. Model Dialogue

A: Do you like shopping for clothes?

B: Yes, I like it very much.

A: What did you buy last weekend?

B: I bought a new T-shirt and jeans.

A: Where do you usually buy clothes?

B: I buy them at the shopping mall.



### 3. Pair Work

Ask your partner:

1. Do you like shopping for clothes?
2. What clothes did you buy recently?
3. What is your favorite item of clothing?
4. Where do you buy clothes?
5. Who do you go shopping with?

#### Useful Phrases

- I like / don't like shopping for ...
- I bought ...
- I wear ...
- T-shirt / jeans / shoes / dress ...

### Quick Challenge

Tell your partner 3 items of clothing you have.

- How often do you buy new clothes?

- What colors do you like wearing?

### 2. Shopping Role Play
