Personalize the Lesson

Make activities about their lives, dreams & interests.

Ask questions like, "What's one place in your city that makes you happy?" instead of "Describe your city."



When students talk about their world, they engage with real energy!



Celebrate Small Wins

Praise even tiny achievements!

Say "I love how you used that word!" or "Great job connecting your ideas!"

Small boosts build big confidence!



Turn Mistakes into Learning Gold

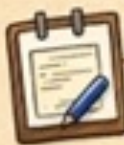
Treat errors as normal learning steps.

Say "Almost! Try again. She is ..."

Then gently model the correct way.

Rephrase what they said correctly, and let them repeat.

No need for long grammar lectures!



End with Reflection & Pride

Close class with 1–2 minutes to share:

"What was useful today?"
or "What are you proud of saying?"
