Vocabulary to Pre-teach

picnic, park, blanket, basket, sandwich, salad, fruit, juice, play games, relax, sunny, enjoy.

Activity 1: Quick Starter (5 min)

Write on the board:

“Do you like picnics?”

- Model: “Yes, I like picnics. I like sandwiches and playing games in the park.”
- Ask several students.

Activity 2: Picnic Mime (5–7 min)

Mime picnic actions: spreading a blanket, eating a sandwich, drinking juice, playing ball, taking photos, etc.

Students guess the actions.

Activity 3: Pair Discussion (5 min)

Students ask each other:

- Do you like going on picnics?
- What food do you take on a picnic?

Teacher Notes & Tips

- This is a fun, visual topic that combines food vocabulary, outdoor activities, and “going to” for plans.
- Great opportunity to review/review food & drink from the previous lesson.
- Focus on positive, descriptive language (beautiful, sunny, delicious, fun, etc.).
- Be ready to teach words like blanket, basket, frisbee, barbecue, etc.
