Topic: Animals (Farm Animals & Wild Animals)

Skills: Vocabulary, Grammar, Speaking, Describing

Time: 60–90 minutes

Central Material: Large animals scene image (PDF 2)

Objectives (Can-Do Statements)

- I can name common farm animals and wild animals.
- I can describe animals (size, color, habitat, what they eat).
- I can talk about where animals live.
- I can say what I like or don't like about animals.

Lead-in Activity (Teacher-Student – 5–8 minutes)

1. Do you like animals? Why or why not?
2. What animals live on a farm?
3. What wild animals do you know?
4. What is your favorite animal? Why?

Test the class with rapid-fire questions.

5. "This animal lives on a farm. It gives us milk. What is it?"
6. "This animal is big and has a long trunk. Where does it live?"
7. "This animal lives in the jungle. It is the king of the animals. What is it?"
8. "This animal has wool and lives on a farm. What animal is it?"

Activity 2: Category Sorting (Listening Game)

Tell the students: "I am going to say an animal. If it lives with a farmer on a farm, shout **FARM!** If it lives free in nature, shout **WILD!**"
