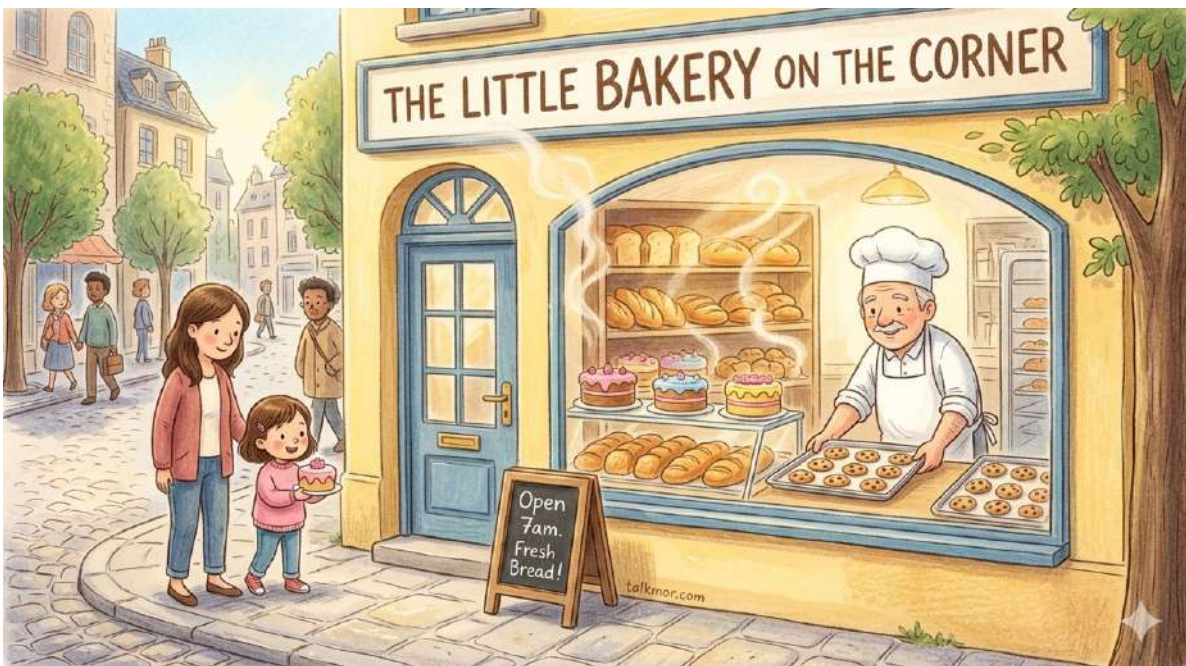

The Little Bakery on the Corner

1. Warm-up (3–5 minutes)

Look at the picture.

- What do you see in the picture?
- Do you have a bakery near your house?
- What do people buy at a bakery?



2. The Story

Inside the bakery, a kind man named Mr. Ben is always smiling. He wears a white hat and a white apron. He loves to bake.

4. Fun Speaking / Personalization (8–10 minutes)

Choose **one** activity:

Option A (Speaking)

You are Lily. Tell your partner:

“What do you buy at the bakery and why?”

Option B (Creative)

Imagine you have your own bakery.

- What is the name of your bakery?
- What color is it?
- What do you sell?
- What is special about it?

Option C (Role Play)

Student A = Mr. Ben

Student B = Customer

Make a short dialogue: “Hello! What would you like today?”

Final Question (Whole class or pairs)
