Activity 4: Who is doing what?

Look at the picture and circle the correct answer:

- The family at the counter **is checking in / boarding** their luggage.
- The people are going **through / waiting** at security.
- The man with the phone **is looking for / boarding** his gate.
- The woman at the desk is **giving directions / selling coffee**.

Activity 5: Match the Situation

- suitcase checking in
- passport passport control

Activity 6: Spot the Object

- A. How many computer screens can you see at the Check-in counters?
 - Answer: [5]
 - *Teacher Note:* There are five blue information monitors hanging directly above the main check-in counter wall.
- B. How many large wheeled suitcases are on the floor/scales?
 - Answer: [6]
 - *Teacher Note:* 1 purple suitcase on the scale, 1 teal suitcase held by the mom, 1 orange suitcase held by the dad, 1 green suitcase held by the man with the phone, 1 red suitcase rolled by the man in the yellow sweater, and 1 orange suitcase rolled by the man with the green backpack. (*Note: This excludes the small backpacks/handbags*).
- C. How many coffee cups are visible at the Café area?
 - Answer: [4]
 - *Teacher Note:* There are 2 cups sitting on the counter ledge, 1 cup being handed over by the barista, and 1 cup held by the customer in the blue shirt.

Activity 7: The "Airport Eye-Spy" Challenge

- Name 3 things that are blue in the picture.
 - **Acceptable Answers:** The hanging check-in screens, the check-in agent uniform shirts, the passport control booth panels, the laptop at the café, the backpack on the walking man in the foreground, or the information desk sign.
- Name 2 children in the picture.
 - **Acceptable Answers:** The young boy and girl standing with the family at the check-in counter (wearing yellow and pink shirts), or the young boy and girl standing near the information desk (wearing green and striped shirts).
- Name 3 different types of luggage.
 - **Acceptable Answers:** Suitcases (wheeled suitcases), backpacks, carry-on bags, or plastic trays (used for loose items at security).
- Find the person who is asking for directions. What is she saying?
 - Answer: She is a worried mother standing at the Information Desk, and her speech bubble says "Directions".
