Teacher's Key

The Market Checklist

- **Bananas:** Countable → **1 big bunch** hanging on the left hook.
- **Rice:** Uncountable.
- **Apples:** Countable → **7 apples** visible in the front basket (plus more in the background stalls).
- **Milk:** Uncountable.
- **Cookies:** Countable → **6 cookies** clearly visible in the front bowl (plus a jar full of them behind).
- **Sugar:** Uncountable.
- **Carrots:** Countable → **5 carrots** in the small wooden basket.
- **Water Bottles:** Countable → **5 individual bottles** in the wooden crate on the right.
- **Flour:** Uncountable.
- **Eggs:** Countable → **10 eggs** visible in the open carton.

Activity 2: True, False, or Secret?

1. **F** (False: There is only **one** big cloth sack of sugar under the table, not a few separate bags).
2. **T** (True: The large white milk jug is full and sitting right in the middle).
3. **S** (Secret: There is no market seller visible in the image! This always makes teenagers laugh or look closer).
4. **F** (False: There are 5 individual water bottles clearly visible in the crate).
5. **F** (False: The flour sack is open, but it is sitting neatly and not spilling onto the floor).
6. **T** (True: The glass jar behind the orange pile is packed full of cookies).
7. **T** (True: The yellow banana bunch is hanging from a black S-hook on the roof beam).
8. **S** (Secret: There are no price tags visible on the fruit baskets).
