1. Grammar Rules: Modifiers vs. Replacers

- **Possessive Adjectives** always need a noun directly *after* them (e.g., **my** football).
- **Possessive Pronouns** stand completely alone. Do *not* put a noun after them (e.g., It is **mine**).

Possessive Adjective (Before Noun)	Possessive Pronoun (Stands Alone)	Example from the Picture
my	mine	This is my football. / This football is mine .
your	yours	Is this your phone? / Is this phone yours ?
his	his	That is his jacket. / That jacket is his .
her	hers	It is her bag. / The bag is hers .
our	ours	This is our camera. / This camera is ours .
their	their	It is their bicycle. / The bicycle is theirs .
