2. Role-Play Cards (Practice in pairs)

Role-Play 1 – Inviting a Friend

Role-Play 2 – At the Picnic

Student B: You are a guest. Ask for food and suggest activities.

Role-Play 3 – Planning a Picnic

Student A & B: You are planning a picnic together next weekend.

Teacher Notes

- Encourage students to use “Let’s...”, “Would you like...?”, and “I’m going to...”
- The mingle activity usually creates a lot of natural repetition and laughter.

Instructions for students:
