### Activity 1: Fashion Market Role-Play (Pair Work)

Work with a partner. **Partner A** and **Partner B**.

**Partner A** – You are a customer at the fashion market.

**Partner B** – You are a shop assistant or a friend.

#### Possible situations:

- Ask for an opinion: “What do you think of this dress?”
- Try on clothes and ask: “Does this look good on me?”
- Ask the price: “How much is this jacket?”
- Bargain or say you like/dislike something.

#### Conversation Guide

- What do you think of ... ?
- I like / don't like this ...
- Can I try it on?
- How much is it?
- It looks nice / great / too big / too small!

### Activity 2: Peer Interview: Style Check

Put the picture away and talk to your classmate about real fashion preferences. Take turns asking and answering.

1. **Q:** “What is your favorite clothing item to wear on the weekend?”

2. **Q:** “Do you like buying new clothes at a street market or an indoor mall?”

**Answer:** I prefer shopping at a.....

3. **Q:** “What color are the shoes you are wearing right now?”

4. **Q:** “How often do you buy new clothes?”

5. **Q:** “Do you prefer wearing bright colors or dark colors?”

6. **Q:** “What is more important to you: comfortable clothes or stylish clothes?”

7. **Q:** “What clothing item do you wear almost every single day?”

8. **Q:** “Do you like wearing hats, sunglasses, or jewelry?”

### Activity 3: Extended Role-Plays (Choose 2–3)

Work with a partner and act out the situations.

1. You are shopping with a friend. Ask for their opinion on different clothes.
2. You are a shop assistant helping a customer.
3. You see something you really like but it's expensive. Try to decide.
4. Talk about your favorite clothes and what you usually wear.

#### Useful Language

- This is too ... (big / small / expensive)
