### Activity 1. Spoken Sentence Builders (Pair Work)

Sit with a partner. Take turns choosing words from Column A, B, and C to make complete, correct spoken sentences about the Lost & Found picture. Your partner must check if it is correct.

### Activity 2: Lost & Found Role-Play

Work with a partner.

One student is **Partner A**, the other is **Partner B**.

**Partner A** – You work at the Lost & Found office.

**Partner B** – You lost something. Go to the office and ask for it.

#### Conversation Guide

- Excuse me, I lost my ...
- Is this yours?
- No, that is not mine. Mine is ...
- This is my ...
- That is his / hers / theirs.

### Activity 3. The "Park Camera" Role-Play

Sit with a partner. Take turns pointing to the big Lost & Found picture, asking simple questions, and answering using correct possessive words.

- Prompt 1 (The Picnic Family) "Look at the family on the blanket. What are they doing?"
  - **Student B:** "They are..."
- Prompt 2 (The Red Book) "Look at the man on the right. Who is he talking to?"
  - **Student A:** "He is..."
- Prompt 3 (The Hula-Hoops) "Look at the three children. What are they playing with?"
  - **Student B:** "They are playing..."
- Prompt 4 (The Artist) "Look at the woman with the tree picture. What is she doing?"
  - **Student A:** "She..."
- Prompt 5 (The Grandparents) "Look at the old man and woman on the bench. Are they happy?" **Student B:** "Yes, they are smiling! He is..."

### Activity 4: Extended Role-Plays (Choose 2-3)

Work with a partner and act out the situations.

1. You found someone's camera. Return it to the owner.
2. At the park, two children are fighting over a ball. Help them.
3. You see a nice backpack. Ask whose it is.
4. Talk about your family's things at the picnic ("This is our picnic basket...").
