Activity 1: Can You Do It? (Group Game)

One student comes to the front and mimes an action from the picture (swimming, playing guitar, riding a bike, painting, cooking, etc.).

The class guesses:

“Can you swim?” / “Can he play the guitar?”

The student answers: “Yes, I can!” or “No, I can’t!”

Activity 2: Would You Rather...? (Discussion)
