Activity 1: Fashion Show Game (Group Game)

One student comes to the front and describes what an imaginary person is wearing (or mimes wearing certain clothes).

The other students guess:

“Is she wearing a red dress?” / “Is he wearing jeans and sneakers?”

The student who guesses correctly gets a point.

Activity 2: Would You Rather...? (Discussion)

Discuss with your partner.

1. Would you rather wear **very fashionable** clothes or **very comfortable** clothes?
2. Would you rather go shopping for clothes for **5 hours** or **never go shopping** again?
3. Would you rather wear the same clothes every day or change your outfit **3 times a day**?
