Activity 1: Two Truths and One Lie

Write 3 sentences about your eating habits using *much / many / a lot of / a little / a few*.
Two are true. One is a lie. Your partner guesses the lie.

Activity 2: Would You Rather...? (Pair Work)

1. Would you rather have **too much** money or **too much** free time?
2. Would you rather eat **a lot of** sweet food or **a lot of** healthy food?
3. Would you rather drink **too much** water or **too little** water?
4. Would you rather buy **many** cheap things or **a few** expensive things?
