### Lesson Overview

This lesson helps students talk about common health problems, describe symptoms, ask for help, and take part in simple doctor-patient conversations.

The activities focus on useful everyday English that students can use in real-life situations.

### Level: A1 – A2

#### Lesson Goals

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

- Talk about common health problems.
- Describe how they feel.
- Ask and answer simple health-related questions.
- Understand basic medical advice.
- Participate in a doctor-patient role-play.

### Warm-Up Activity 1

#### Think and Discuss

Ask students:

1. When was the last time you were sick?
2. Do you like going to the doctor? Why or why not?
3. What do you usually do when you have a cold?
4. Do you prefer medicine or home remedies?
5. How often do you visit a doctor?
6. What advice do you give a friend who feels sick?

#### Teaching Notes

- Encourage students to speak in complete sentences.
- Accept simple answers from weaker students.
- Focus on communication rather than perfect grammar.
- Allow students time to share personal experiences.
- Use the warm-up activities to identify vocabulary students already know.
