Learning Objectives

- **Where** → places
- **When** → time
- **Who** → people
- **Why** → reasons
- **How** → manner / way / feeling

2. Where are you from?
3. When is your birthday?
4. Who is your favourite singer / footballer?
5. Why do you study English?
6. How are you today?

Teaching Tips

- Teach the question words one by one with clear meaning and examples.
- Focus heavily on word order: WH word + auxiliary (do/does) + subject + verb.
- Use lots of pair work and personal questions.
- Common mistakes: missing auxiliary (What you like?), wrong word order, confusing When/Where/Why
