Lesson Objective

Students will learn about La Tomatina, a famous festival in Spain where people throw tomatoes at each other for fun.

Students will practice:

- speaking
- simple descriptions
- sharing opinions
- asking and answering questions

Warm-Up Questions

Ask students:

1. Do you like tomatoes?
2. What is your favorite vegetable?
3. Have you ever been to a festival?
4. Do you enjoy outdoor events?
5. Do you like messy activities?

Raise Your Hand...

Raise your hand if:

- you like tomatoes
- you enjoy festivals
- you like taking photos
- you would visit Spain
- you think La Tomatina looks fun

Would you join La Tomatina?

- Yes Maybe No

Ask several students to explain their answer.

Introduce the Topic

Tell students:

La Tomatina is a famous festival in Spain. Every year, thousands of people throw tomatoes at each other and have fun.

Ask:

- Does this sound fun?
- Would you like to join?
- Why or why not?

Quick Think

Which sounds more fun?

- Going to a concert
- Going to La Tomatina

Which sounds more unusual?

- Watching a football match
- Throwing tomatoes at strangers

Which sounds messier?

- Cooking dinner
- Joining La Tomatina

Teacher Tip

Do not explain too much about the festival yet.

Allow students to guess and share ideas first.

The image and discussion will naturally create curiosity for the next activities.
