### 1. Complete the Dialogues

#### Dialogue 1 – Basic Introduction

#### Example:

“Hi, I'm Pedro. I'm from Spain. I like football. Nice to meet you!”

### 4. Free Speaking – “Find Out About Your Partner”

Work with a partner and ask each other questions.

Then introduce your partner to the class.

#### Example:

“This is Sofia. She is from Peru. She lives in Lima. She likes dancing and her hobby is drawing.”

### 2. Role-Play Cards

#### Student A

Introduce yourself and ask questions.

#### Student B

Introduce yourself and answer questions.

#### Useful Language:

Introducing yourself:

- Hi, my name is ...
- I'm from ...
- I live in ...
- I'm a ...
- I like ...
- My hobby is ...

#### Asking questions:

- What's your name?
- Where are you from?
- Where do you live?
- What do you do?
- What do you like to do?
- What's your hobby?

#### Teacher Tip

Focus on natural intonation and eye contact.

Encourage students to smile when introducing themselves.
