# Have Got / Has Got

## A1-A2 ENGLISH WORKSHEET

**We use Have Got / Has Got to talk about things we own, people in our family, and descriptions.**

**AFFIRMATIVE (+)**

I / You / We / They have got ...  
He / She / It has got ...

**NEGATIVE (-)**

I / You / We / They have not got ...  
He / She / It has not got ...

**USE**

- to talk about possession
- to talk about people in a family
- to describe something

**Remember!**  
He / She / It uses **HAS GOT**.  
All others use **HAVE GOT**.

**QUESTIONS (?)**

Have I / you / we / they got ...?  
Has he / she / it got ...?

**SHORT ANSWERS**

Yes, I / you / we / they have.  
No, I / you / we / they haven't.

Yes, he / she / it has.  
No, he / she / it hasn't.

**CONTRACTIONS**

have got → 've got  
has got → 's got  
have not got → haven't got  
has not got → hasn't got

**EXAMPLES**

We have got a big house.

They have got two children.

I have got a red car.

She has got a nice phone.

He has got a lot of books.

It has got long ears.

We have got some milk.

You haven't got a skateboard.

**POSSESSIONS**

I have got a bicycle.

You have got a laptop.

He has got a guitar.

She has got a camera.

**FAMILY**

I have got a sister.

He has got two brothers.

She has got a baby brother.

**DESCRIPTIONS**

He has got black hair.

She has got brown eyes.

It has got two pockets.

It has got a short tail.
