Regular & Irregular Past Simple Verbs

Regular Verbs
Add -ed to the base form.

He **locked** the door.

She **studied** English.

They **cooked** dinner.

I **played** football.

Irregular Verbs
The past form changes!

She **ate** pizza.

He **read** a book.

They **went** to Italy.

I **drove** my car.

- ✓ yesterday
- ✓ last night
- ✓ last week
- ✓ last month
- ✓ last year
- ✓ ago
- ✓ in 2010
- ✓ in the past

Did you know?

- ✓ Regular verbs follow rules.
- ✓ Irregular verbs don't follow rules.
- ✓ You need to learn them!

Remember!
The verb changes to show the action already happened.

EXAMPLES OF REGULAR VERBS

walk - walked	watch - watched
talk - talked	clean - cleaned
play - played	help - helped
look - looked	visit - visited

SPELLING RULES FOR -ED

play → played	stop → stopped (double the last letter)
watch → watched	try → tried (change y to i)
study → studied	

EXAMPLES OF IRREGULAR VERBS

go - went	come - came
eat - ate	take - took
see - saw	make - made
have - had	do - did
