Choose a side and **prepare 2–3 reasons**.

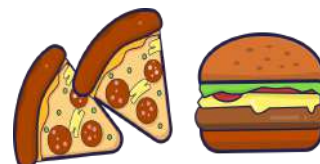

- Talk about your favorite foods.

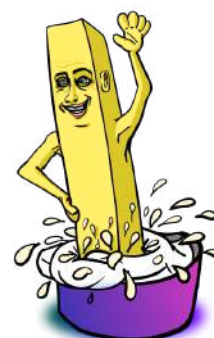


6. Creative Activity
