



REGULAR & IRREGULAR PAST SIMPLE

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Activity 1 – Past Simple Adventure Board

Instructions

Place a coin, eraser, or pencil tip on **START**.

Take turns moving around the board.

When you land on a square, complete the challenge before moving again.

Activity 2 – Verb Charades
